Options Counseling Certifications/Trainings

- Currently 64 Certified Options Counselors in the State

Options Counseling-Contact Information Changes

- Jan Moxley is currently working on HCCBG funding; she is advocating for OC to be a billable item for HCCBG funds

- Michael Howard is now taking over as the new contact person for Options Counseling
- Donna Holt is the person to contact for technical assistance for OC

LCA Outreach-Ideas/Brainstorming

- Several Nursing Facilities still have not made referrals for LCA
- The LCA group needs fresh ideas on how to reach out to NF and their staff
- Team looked at print-out from the state on how LOS compares to other regions
- Team suggested bringing the LCA topic up at the Nursing Facilities Administrators Meeting
- Suggestion was made that it would be helpful for Ombudsman to have packet to take to NF for technical assistance

Challenges for CRC Discussion

- State needs broad based issues for CRC if funding didn't continue
- Team Stated:
 - Without funding there would be no reporting (i.e. SART; quarterly reports)
 - Less networking
 - Less Best Practice
 - No quarterly meetings; less information gathering opportunities
 - No rack cards/no advertising
 - No County Directories
 - Lose community support
 - Options Counseling would go down the drain; less interest in pursuing it
